- The instructor sent an unnecessary amount of convoluted emails, and nothing about the way that she grades is particularly clear. Every time a student asked a question, she sent a very long email that very rarely answered the question. Any time a technical difficulty arose, she told us to ask ITG for help, rather than handling it herself, even though the issue was always something she could have easily fixed herself. She is not rude, and it seems that, in theory, she wants to be helpful, but she in practice she is not very helpful, and she makes everything much more complicated than it needs to be. I also think that refusing to open the materials for the week until Tuesday (rather than even Monday) is unfair to students who have other responsibilities and cannot necessarily abide by her strict weekly schedule- the point of an online asynchronous class is that it is at least partially asynchronous. She seems to be out of touch with the reality of students lives. All this to say, the course would be greatly improved if the instructor made her grading criteria clear, abided by the structure of an asynchronous class, actually made an effort to help students, and proofread her emails to that they actually conveyed information concisely and effectively.

- The biggest difficulty for me in this course was the fact that I thought it inhibited the Jewish perspective and historical significance of the spring and growth of Christianity. Because the professor is not Jewish, the course was taught very much from the Christian perspective, with Jewish students attempting to "fill in the gaps" where questions arose. I understand that Christianity did spring from Judaism, but it is so essential for students to learn Jewish thought and practice as it is related to early Christianity, and even modern Christianity (if possible), so that the we don't further create antisemitic thoughts around the question of whether Christianity did or did not come from Judaism. I wish there was more Jewish perspective as well as Jewish text learning as well as an exploration into the Jewish messiah, not only a discussion around Jesus. I was nevertheless fascinated by my learnings of Christianity, but not at the stunt of Jewish context learning in relation, that should be balanced.
